Dear Parent/Carers

I am writing to provide the final arrangements of the year 3/4 STEM trip to Bristol leaving school at 0730 on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> June and returning on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June at approximately 1630.

Please be at school by **0715 on Wednesday 20**<sup>th</sup> **June** to load the coach. We need to depart by 0730 to get to Bristol Zoo gardens by 1100. We should arrive back in school at approximately **1630 on Friday 22**<sup>nd</sup> **June.** As we pass Exeter on the way home I will phone Mrs Wood and ask her to text every one of our arrival time.

Please take these items on the coach in a small rucksack:

- 1. A substantial packed lunch this must last all day until 5.45pm. No lunch boxes please a plastic bag which can be reused will be ideal.
- 2. A large, full drinks bottle which doesn't leak!
- 3. A small bottle of sun cream. No sprays please.
- 4. Camera not essential and taken at own risk.
- 5. Wallet their pocket money will be handed to them on a daily basis.
- 6. Waterproof coat.
- 7. Hat I will provide these on the day.

Please pack these items in a holdall or small suitcase:

- 1. Pyjamas with suitable evening shoes (crocs or slippers no flip flops)
- 2. Towel
- 3. Wash bag with toiletries
- 4. Suitable spare clothes
- 5. A warm jumper or hoody.

The children are welcome to take MP3 players, Ipods, books etc but these items are entirely at their own risk. No mobile phones please. It will help tremendously if all of these items are labelled with your child's name.
