boards and one group did rescue tubes. Our team name were the elite flossers. We had to partner up and ask them the CHUMS questions:

C= chums. Do you have any friends with you? H= head. Have you hit you head? U= unconscious. Have you been unconscious? M= medication. Are you on any meds?

S= seawater. Have you inhaled any seawater?

With the nipper boards we formed a raft and ran across it into the sea. It was really fun. Also we learnt how to stand up on the boards. It was so hot so the sea didn't feel cold at all. All in all it was great fun although it was very hot! By Roisin and Evie.
