

PENPONDS NATIVITY


It will take place on Sunday 11th December meeting in the square at 4 o'clock then processing to the church.

Christmas card with a nice message inside

Toiletries of all sorts are always needed; shampoo/conditioner, shower gel, wet wipes, toothpaste/toothbrushes, mouthwash, vaseline/lip balm, sanitary products, flannels, razors, shaving foam, handcream, hair brushes & hairbands,

Treats, such as chocolates, sweets, sachets of drinks/cup a soup, biscuits, maybe items such as a book, a notepad and pen/pencil, a torch, batteries, travel first aid.

Other small items such as ear plugs, eye masks, small towels, hat/gloves/scarves and underwear particularly socks – (Underwear must be new, with tags, please)
