

Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day Appeal



Common tricks are apps or games that have a sliphtly different name to the genuine article (Fornight rather than Fornite, for instance) or use logos which deliberately look very similar to the official app. To avoid downloading these imitations, read the app's description and check who the publisher is listed as. ъ
