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This week's focus: Tregonning class trip to Truro Museum.

On Tuesday 20th September, Tregonning class went on a trip to Truro museum to learn about the Ancient Greeks. When we got there, we went into a little room, put our bags and coats on a peg and sat on a bench. After 5 minutes, Lorna and Susannah came and put us into two groups. One group went and looked at Greek pots, the other group made clay tiles representing the Greeks.

Next, we went upstairs to handle some Greek pots, all of them were real but two. We put gloves on to handle them, so that the pot didn't get damaged. Then we designed our own pot before going back downstairs to swap with the other group.

In the other activity, we rolled clay and cut out a pot shape. Then we decorated it with Greek patterns and pictures of daily life. We painted back slip onto the tiles to colour it in.

After we had lunch, we split into smaller groups and went wherever we wanted to go to explore the museum. One group went into the shop, another went and looked at more history and the other looked at the Bloodhound. Finally, all the groups went to the shop. Thomas got a ball and an amethyst and Paul bought a marble egg. Then everyone went outside to wait for the bus but it finally arrived and everyone went back to school.
