We were concerned that with smaller cohorts and the growing trophies, the children may worry about 7 out of the 19 children getting an award and the rest not. I know last year, 7 out of 13 were given a trophy.

We spoke to the children and asked what they wanted to do. We talked about reducing the trophies, adding to them, keeping what we have already and adding personal additional awards and the children decided they didn't want to change anything. We always respect the views of our children and we were very impressed by their attitude and maturity.

As a rights respecting school, we listen to their right to a voice - so we have followed their wishes with the Year 6 awards this year. These will be awarded to the Year 6 children in their Year 6 Leavers Assembly on the last day of term Friday 22nd July at 2:30pm. Year 6 parents are invited to attend this special celebration and join the school in wishing our wonderful Year 6s all the best for the next steps of their future!
