This week's focus: Prefect awards

Children apply for a prefect badge in writing to Mr Richards. The staff consider the applications before awarding the badges/ties in a celebration assembly. Prefects take on several responsibilities around the school, for example, they help at lunchtimes, act as librarians, tour prospective parents and visitors around the school and organise games for younger children to name but a few. As a reward for completing these responsibilities each half term there will be a Prefect Treat, such as a visit to the Maritime Museum or the Hall for Cornwall. However, once a badge is awarded it can be taken away, as prefects have to continue to uphold the standards they set in achieving the badges in the first place.
