Unfortunately, due to the latest guidance and rising rates of Covid infections in Cornwall we are **unable** to invite parents in for our sports days in July. Message from Jo Greet (CSIA) for parents of Year 6 children who are moving on to Camborne academy in September.

Sadly, we will not be able to invite Year 6 students to attend their transition day in July or to invite parents to attend a transition evening. As last year, we will be inviting parents and carers to register for our Virtual Transition Portal; they will receive a text message with a link w/c 21 June 2021.
