Dear Parents/carers,

We hope you had an enjoyable half-term with you families, even though the weather wasn't the best. As you will be aware, we will be going into another lockdown from Thursday of this week in England. As announced schools will remain open and attendance at school will continue to be mandatory. In order that we can keep our school open for as many children as possible we must make sure we continue to stick to the staggered drop off and pick-up times alongside all the other measures we have in place in school. Please ensure when dropping children, you maintain social distancing rules and avoid congregating in groups on the school premises. Please do not arrive on site until your allotted time. I know this may be an inconvenience if you have more than one child to drop at different times, but I think you will all agree this is preferable to the schools being closed. We will continue to follow guidance from the Department for Education on steps to take in the instance of a positive case in school. If that means a 'bubble' of children needs to isolate our teachers have worked hard to ensure we have remote education learning plans in place so there will be as little a disruption to the children as possible.

We all know that the best place for children to learn is in the classroom with their class teacher so let's all work together to keep our children and staff safe so they can remain in front of the class and doing what they do best. Please make sure you follow the most recent guidance if you or your child develop symptoms and if in doubt please contact the school. Be patient with our fantastic office staff who are not trained medical professionals, but they will be able to help interpret the guidance if needed.

We are aware this next lockdown will be a challenging time in many ways for our families, emotionally and financially in some cases. We have a strong sense of community and I am sure we can work together to keep schools open and ensure the best possible education for your children.


