This week's focus: Being Victorians!

On Tuesday 12th November Tregonning Class had a Victorian day to celebrate our topic. It started with having our photos taken in groups or alone. We all had to look serious because in the Victorian era cameras took a long time to focus and it is hard to keep smiling for a long period of time.

Then, we were divided into four groups and started to bake bread. It was hard to knead the dough as it kept sticking in separate lumps. After that, we left the dough to rise. My group made butter. To make it we had to shake cream until it formed into a solid lump. Next, we moulded marzipan into fruit shapes. Marzipan becomes harder over time thus making it increasingly more difficult to shape. We also took turns to stir gruel, a kind of porridge.



After lunch we had a Victorian school workshop. We completed a work sheet which required us to study punishment, books and newspaper articles and an old school plan of Penponds! We also got to work out arithmetic questions on slates which made a horrible noise when written on, and did handwriting using dip-pens which made a huge wet patch on my paper. I'm glad we don't use dip-pens now!

Camborne Lantern Parade – Friday 29th November



The lantern parade will take place on the 29th November this year. The road will be closed from 4.45pm with the parade starting at 5.30pm. Please meet at 5.15pm in Rectory Road (near St Meriadoc Infants school). Please bring along any lanterns that you made last year and were unable to use due to the bad weather. As well as the large lantern made in school last year Tregonning class are making

some medium sized lanterns to carry in pairs. Reception children will also be making some small lanterns.

The road closures will be rolling closures this year so the roads will be opened as soon as the last group and traffic marshal have moved through. When the parade makes it around to the square, the marshals will be ushering the large lanterns past on one side of the street so that they can be taken back to St Meriadoc Infants and the parents and children can gather to watch the switch on. NB Children must be accompanied by a parent at all times. Penponds staff will not be responsible for supervising the children as they will be carrying the large lanterns.

If the weather is looking bad for the Friday, we will be notified of any changes/cancellation to either the parade or timings for the switch on by the Thursday.
