Everyday across the school the children practice, 'Fast Learning'. Using a maths grid like the one shown here, the children time themselves on precise, accurate rapid recall of number facts or calculation strategies. Children aim to



achieve their Personal Best, or PB, by working quickly through the grid to really embed their knowledge. We've seen real success with this strategy with children moving from 14 mins to complete a grid to under five minutes over a 6-week period. As facts are learnt new calculations are added such as multiplying fractions to keep moving the cutting edge of learning forward.

Mini Olympics at CSIA with Trencom class.

Yesterday we went to CSIA to compete against other primary schools. We did the 600m, 100m, 200m, high jump, Frisbee throwing, long jump, rock climbing, javelin, blindfold course and shot put. TJ won the blindfold course challenge and Alex won the 200m. Morley was second in the Frisbee throwing with Jayden taking first place. Someone from Rosemellion school won the javelin. Although it was very sunny the wind made it freezing cold. TJ said, "it was one of the coldest days ever in school!". Grooming Inappropriate Websites

- Over half of 12 15 year olds say they mostly use the internet alone.
- 41% of parents of this age group say that their child has internet access in their bedroom.
- 48% of parents think their child knows more about the internet than they
 do.






