This term each class will be studying an aspect of Cornwall through class reading books, trips, geography and local history. **Tregonning class** will learn all about the history of Cornish Mining and the geography of the local area. This week they animated the legend of the Cornish giants, Corin and Gogmagog. They also created their first art work of the term in the form of sunset landscapes taking inspiration from our engine houses dotted on the cliffs. They learnt about the ancient sport of

Cornish Wrestling and practised a Tin Mining song.




Cornish Pirates – Godolphin Class



Please note that attending a school's nursery does not guarantee your child a place at that school – you still need to apply. The criteria in the school's admission arrangements will be used to allocate places.




