



This week's focus: Tregonning class visit to Porthcurno Telegraph museum

People dressed up in WW2 costumes and we found out about the communications that were used 70 years ago. Then we went into the underground part of the museum – it was very surprising as it wasn't tunnels. We saw working machines and typewriters that were actually used in WW2 including gas masks for babies! We climbed up the escape stairs which had been cut out of the cliff. It was really steep with 120 steps and we had to wear hard hats on the low ceilings. At the top we had a class photo and had our lunch including going in the shop! Andarras Multi Academy trust visit to Penponds School



On Tuesday morning we hosted teachers and head teachers form the Andarras Multi Academy Trust, a group of schools in Launceston. They had heard about our Maths learning ladders and investigations and wanted to see for themselves the strategy to see if they could apply it to their schools. The Learning Ambassadors talked the adults through their work books, fast arithmetic and maths investigations before taking them on a tour of the school to see the Learning Ladders in action. Afterwards they gave us lovely feedback on our standards and how confident the children were in their learning. Thank you to our staff who hosted them first thing in the morning especially straight after half term.

Weight and Capacity learning in Year 1

Year 1 have been learning about weight and capacity. We had an investigation to find out how many litres of water it would take to fill up our water tray. The children made predictions using mathematical language for their predictions. We then went outside and carried out our experiment! The children were careful to watch and make sure we were measuring correctly and counted how many litres it would take! The end total was 72 litres. Great work Year 1


